CIRCULAR

In pursuance of the representation from stakeholder, the Ministry of Textiles vide its letter No. 11/02/2020-Samarth dated 12.05.2021 directed that the failed and absent trainees may be given a chance to re-appear for the assessment. In line with the direction of Ministry of Textiles, all the Assessment Agencies (AAs) are directed to take note of the following for record and appropriate complacence.

i. Re-assessment of Failed candidates:

If a trainee has attended all the training sessions and is eligible to go for assessment but fails to secure minimum 60 % marks required to clear the assessment he/she will be given a chance to take up the supplementary assessment. However, before the supplementary assessment, the trainee shall undergo mandatory 10 hour theory class and 20 hours practice class. Assessment of such candidate will be taken up along with other batch of same course and at same location/Training Centre (TC)

ii. Assessment of Absent candidates:

It is observed that on many occasions, candidates do not attend the assessment due to the various reasons. If any bonafied trainee who fulfills other criteria such as attendance, etc and willing to undergo the assessment may be given a chance to attend the assessment along with next batch in the same location/TC. The maximum time limit from batch end date to assessment may be 3 months and not more than 10% of trainees are allowed.

iii. All Implementing Partner (IP)/TC may communicate to PMU/RSA about all such candidates who are willing to reappear for assessment. The PMU will intimate position of such candidate to AA designated to take up assessment on next batch with a copy to RSA. On receipt of such communication from PMU/RSA, AA will take up assessment of all such trainees.
